Election Process:

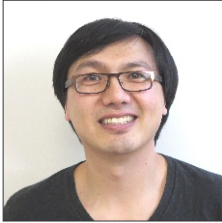
There are 5 Elder candidates nominated:

Dominic Fung



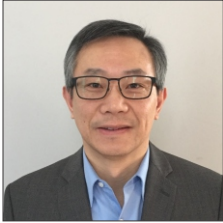
