

## Psalm 119: Delighting in Right Living Psalm 119:9-16; Daniel 5



### Here's what happens...

The psalmist delights in God's Word, storing it in his heart so he won't sin against God. When King Belshazzar is sinning against God, God sends a finger to write God's judgment on the wall. Daniel, who knows God's Word, is able to discern what the writing on the wall means about the king's sinful behavior.

### Bible Point:

God's Word helps us live right.

*"Your word is a lamp to guide my feet and a light for my path"  
(Psalm 119:105).*
