WHAT IS A SMALL GROUP?

A typical meeting may consist of singing praises, studying the Bible, learning, serving, sharing, praying and refreshments. It is a common understanding amongst the group members to respect sharing in confidence. Many groups host special events and enjoy outings and retreats together.


